**HAVING REGARD** to Italian Presidential Decree 28.12.2000, no. 445;

**HAVING REGARD** to Articles 2 and 12 of Italian Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, “Equal treatment in the right to university studies”;

**HAVING REGARD** to the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued by Rector’s Decree no. 828, ref. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Art. 75 and 79;

**HAVING REGARD** to the letter, ref. no. 211307 of 06/09/2024 with which Antonio Grassi, legal representative of the Rotary Club Crema, expresses the intention to donate to Politecnico di Milano the sum of €5,000.00 to establish a study scholarship entitled “Dott. Mario Buzzella”, intended for needy and worthy students on Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes in engineering of Politecnico di Milano, with preference for the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme in Materials Engineering and Nanotechnology;

**HAVING REGARD** to Managerial Decree no. 11204/2024 Prot n. 211399/2024 of 6/09/2024, which declares to accept the donation offered by Rotary Club Crema;

### **HEREBY DECREES**

The issuance of the call for applications **for 1 “Dott. Mario Buzzella” study scholarship a.y. 2024/2025.**

#### **Art. 1**

##### **Characteristics of the study scholarship and recipients**

No. 1 study scholarship, in the gross amount of **€5,000.00**, including costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, is to be allocated to students **of the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme in Materials Engineering and Nanotechnology** of Politecnico di Milano.

#### **Art. 2**

##### **Participation requirements**

Students possessing the following requirements by the call deadline may participate in the competition:

1. **enrolment in the a.y. 2023/2024** on the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme in Materials Engineering and Nanotechnology of Politecnico di Milano;
2. **enrolment in the a.y. 2024/2025** on the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme in Materials Engineering and Nanotechnology of Politecnico di Milano
3. **at least 70 CFU** useful for achieving the qualification taken and duly recorded in the career (validations included)

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will ascertain possession of the requirements present in the IT archive of Politecnico di Milano.

Applicants are responsible for checking, within the deadline, that the data in the database of the Politecnico di Milano are correct and updated.

### **Art. 3**

#### **How to participate**

Applicants must submit the application by way of the specific function available from the online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **from 15 January 2025 to 28 March 2025 at 12 pm (noon - Italian time)**.

The completion of the online application (status:closed)is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

### **Art. 4**

#### **Assignment of the scholarship**

The assignment of the scholarships is decided based upon a ranking drawn up by the Fundraising and Alumni Unit based on what is present in the database of Politecnico di Milano.

The ranking will be formulated based upon the score determined by the formula:

**(WEIGHTED AVERAGE x CFU RECORDED) + ECONOMIC CONDITION SCORE  
(at the call deadline)**

The economic condition score is determined as follows:

To that end, the **valid and compliant 2025 ISEE** (equivalent **ISEEU** for those not earning income in Italy), found in the University’s **database** by the **call deadline** will be considered.

**In the absence** of a valid and compliant **2025 ISEE/ISEEU** the student will be **attributed**, solely for the purposes of this ranking, the **highest ISEE/ISEEU (€95,001)**.

If the applicants are still equal, priority will be given to the youngest applicant.

The scholarship may not be assigned if the applicants are unsuitable.

The ranking will be posted on the University’s website in the section:

The winner may be invited to a meet-and-greet with the donor.

**art. 5**  
**General Rules**

**Accumulation:** the scholarship and any renewals cannot be combined with other scholarships or other forms of financial aid provided by the Politecnico for the same academic year, and in particular they cannot be combined with 'Diritto allo Studio' (DSU) benefits. The scholarship and any renewals may be combined with the international mobility contributions provided by Politecnico or by other public or private entities. The scholarship and any renewals may be combined with exemptions from tuition fees and contributions.

**Payment:** the winner will be notified of the awarding of the scholarship and its renewals at his/her University institutional e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving said notification, the winner must sign and return the corresponding forms attached to the award and renewal notifications.

The scholarship will be disbursed by Politecnico di Milano in a single payment.

In the event that the scholarship is not awarded and/or the holder fails to renew the scholarship, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call for applications.

**Withdrawal:** if the winner withdraws or fails to return the forms, the award will be transferred to the next suitable applicant in the ranking.

**Revocation:** the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the recipient. In any case, the scholarship will be revoked if the recipient withdraws from his/her studies or transfers to another University during the year.

Revocation will require the amount received to be returned to the Politecnico di Milano and the amount will be used to set up a new call for applications.

**Self-certification:** Politecnico di Milano will verify the recipient's declarations and any false declarations will result in the forfeiture of any benefits awarded.

**Taxation:** the amount awarded will be subject to taxation, in accordance with current legislation relating to scholarships. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is therefore treated in the same way for tax purposes. The costs to be borne by Politecnico di Milano are the IRAP regional tax on production activities, amounting to 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

## **PRIVACY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)**

Politecnico di Milano (hereafter also *Politecnico*), in the role of Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, hereby informs you of the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and respective implementing regulations (hereafter the *Regulation*).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

### **A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED**

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** the data collected upon submitting your application, particularly those relating to your academic career and economic condition.

### **B. PURPOSES AND METHODS OF PROCESSING**

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

### **C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION**

The provision of data for the purposes indicated in section B 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide such data will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the procedure.

#### **D. SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION OF THE DATA**

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

**Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.**

**If any contact is made by the donor, the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller** of data processing. Therefore, the donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

#### **E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA**

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

#### **F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD**

Your personal data will be retained only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

#### **G. YOUR RIGHTS**

You have the right to:

obtain information on the methods by which your data are processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (so-called *right of access*)

to rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (so-called *right to rectification*)



to restrict the processing of your personal data pursuant to

Art. 18 of the Regulation (so-called *right to restriction*);

to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (so-called *right to object*)
